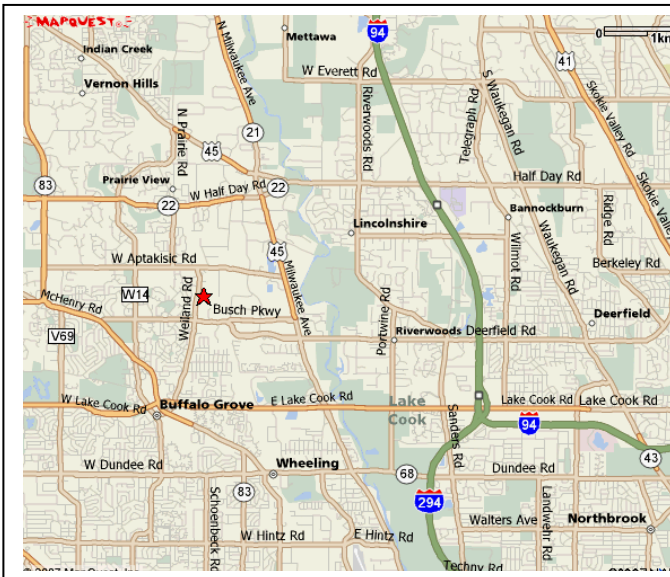

Map & Directions to Rink (1500 Abbott Court; Buffalo Grove, IL 60089):

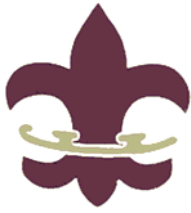


Driving Instructions:

Official Announcement 2009 DuPage Open August 13-16, 2009

Rules and Eligibility

The 2009 DuPage Open Competition is a United States Figure Skating (USFS) sanctioned, non-qualifying competition, and will be conducted under the rules of USFS as set forth in the 2009-2010 Rulebook. Rule changes made at the May 2009 Governing Council will apply at this competition. Testing cut-off date for eligibility will be **September 1, 2009**. Skaters may skate up one level from their current testing status as of the entry date. However, all events must be skated at the same level. **Skaters who placed First in the Final round of a 2009 Qualifying Competition in their division must move up one level.** Once entries have closed, entry fees are only refundable if the competition is not held (Rule 3235).

Entry Form Deadline

All entry forms for the 2009 DuPage Open Competition must be postmarked by **Wednesday, July 1, 2009**. Metered postage will not be acceptable. Any Application postmarked after July 1, 2009, will be considered a late entry and will be assessed a \$30.00 late fee OR may not be accepted. Your email address is required so that we may confirm that we received your entry form.

ISU Judging System (IJS) and Related Information

The ISU Judging System (IJS) will be used to determine the results for all single events, Juvenile through Senior. Included this year is Open Juvenile, so that skaters at this level may become acclimated to the new IJS. All other events will be judged using the 6.0 system.

All Juvenile, Open Juvenile through Senior singles skaters MUST enter their respective PROGRAM CONTENT FORM online to US Figure Skating (www.usfsa.org) no later than August 6, 2009. Forms will NOT be accepted at Registration.

Please note that for competitors entering Pairs events, a separate entry form for each skater must be submitted.

Championship rounds will be held for Juvenile through Novice free skating events.

All fees must accompany application entry. Please mail separate check for each skater entering the competition.

Competition Schedule of Events

A tentative schedule will be available by **August 1, 2009** on our website, www.dupagefsc.org. Individual event time notifications will **not be mailed or e-mailed**, so all competitors must check the website after August 1st for their own individual event times.

Practice Ice

Practice ice may be purchased through the Twin Rinks Ice Pavilion by email sales only after Thursday, August 6, 2009 at www.dupageice@twinrinks.com (See Practice Ice Info page). The DuPage FSC will not be responsible for practice ice.

Facility

The Twin Rinks Ice Pavilion is located at 1500 Abbott Court, Buffalo Grove, IL, 60089. 847-821-7465. The facility has two sheets of ice with seating (Blue Rink; Red Rink), and each surface measures 85' x 200'.

Official Notices

An official bulletin board will be maintained at the main arena. It is the responsibility of each competitor, parent and coach to check the board frequently for any schedule changes and additional information.

Scratches

No refunds will be made after the competition entry deadline of July 1, 2009. If you must withdraw from an event, please be considerate of other competitors and notify the registration desk as soon as possible.

Music

Competitors must provide their music on cassette tapes or CDs. All cassette tapes or CDs must be clearly marked with the skater's Name, Event, and Actual Time of Music ON THE SIDE TO BE PLAYED. Cassette tapes should be of good quality with only ONE piece of music per cassette and rewound to the beginning of the program. CDs must have only ONE track on it. In the case of short and long programs, two separate CDs (or cassettes) must be used. Damaged or improperly marked cassettes or CDs will not be accepted. For CDs, due to compatibility and reliability reasons, music should not be submitted on re-recordable "CD-RW" discs.

Music should be turned in at the designated check in area where their event is taking place (Red rink or Blue rink). COMPETITORS MUST HAVE A SUITABLE BACKUP CD OR CASSETTE DURING HIS/HER EVENT. Skaters are responsible for picking up their tapes and CDs at the arena check-in desk after your event. The DuPage FSC and the Twin Rinks Ice Pavilion are not responsible for tapes or CDs that are lost, damaged or left behind, and these will not be mailed back.

Registration Desk

The Registration Desk is located in the main lobby and will be open approximately 1 hour prior to the start of the competition each day and will remain open throughout the competition. Skaters must check in at least 1 hour prior to the start of their event warm up. For further information or questions regarding the competition, you can also call Eileen Serafine at 847-234-4659 between the hours of 9am – 8pm.

Awards

Non-championship events will be divided into groups when necessary. Referee will seed Juvenile through Novice events. Awards will be presented to the top four placements in each group/flight; this includes the top four skaters in initial rounds and also final rounds. All awards will be presented off ice immediately following the completion of the event and posting of the results and pictures will be taken immediately thereafter as the awards are distributed.

Photography, Video and Vendors

Videography service will be provided by Local Motion Productions (www.lmpvideo.com) at the competition. Photography service will also be available. Additional information and order forms will be available at their designated vendor tables. No flash photography is permitted in the ice arenas. The use of ice arena power sources is also prohibited. Any vendor that wishes to be present at the competition must be given **prior approval** by the DuPage FSC. Please contact Jan Serafine at sk8judg@aol.com.

Official Hotel
