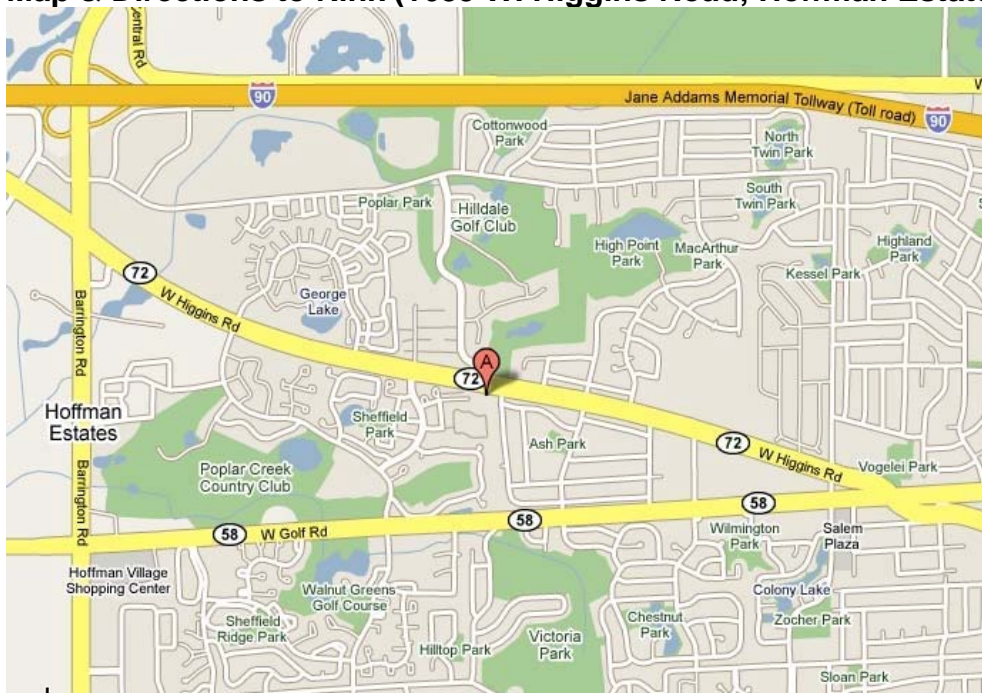

Rules and Eligibility

The 2011 DuPage Open Competition is a United States Figure Skating (USFS) sanctioned, non-qualifying competition, and will be conducted under the rules of USFS as set forth in the 2011-2012 Rulebook. Rule changes made at the April 2011 Governing Council for the 2011-12 season will apply at this competition. Testing cut-off date for eligibility will be **September 1, 2011**. Skaters may skate up one level from their current testing status as of the entry date. However, all events must be skated at the same level. **Skaters who placed First in the Final round of a 2011 Qualifying Competition in their division must move up one level.** Once entries have closed, entry fees are only refundable if the competition is not held (Rule 3235).

Entry Form Deadline

All entry forms for the 2011 DuPage Open Competition must be postmarked by **Friday, July 1, 2011**. Metered postage will not be acceptable. Any Application postmarked after July 1, 2011, will be considered a late entry and will be assessed a \$30.00 late fee OR may not be accepted. **Your email address is required** so that we may confirm that we received your entry form.

ISU Judging System (IJS) and Related Information

The ISU Judging System (IJS) will be used to determine the results for all single events, Juvenile through Senior. Included this year is Open Juvenile, so that skaters at this level may become acclimated to the new IJS. All other events will be judged using the 6.0 system.

All Juvenile, Open Juvenile through Senior singles skaters MUST enter their respective PROGRAM CONTENT FORM online to US Figure Skating (www.usfsa.org) no later than August 4, 2011. Forms will NOT be accepted at Registration.

Please note that for competitors entering Pairs events, a separate entry form for each skater must be submitted. Championship rounds will be held for Juvenile and for Intermediate and Novice combined events. All fees must accompany application entry. Please mail separate check for each skater entering the competition. Make check or money order payable to: **2011 DuPage Open**.

Competition Schedule of Events

A tentative schedule will be available by **August 1, 2011** on our website, www.dupagefsc.org. Individual event time notifications will **not be mailed or e-mailed**, so all competitors must check the website after August 1st for their own individual event times.

Videography. NEW!!

Each entry will receive their group DVD for each event entered as inclusive in the entry fee. For example, in the Intermediate combined event, a DVD will be provided for the short program, another for the free skate, and another if participating in final round, and another dvd of each compulsory moves, spin or jumps events entered as well.

Evaluation Group Sessions

A Technical specialist will conduct a group evaluation session after Thursday & Friday initial round IJS events as available.

Practice Ice

Practice ice is coordinated by the **Triphahn Center (formerly Hoffman Estates Ice Arena)**, not the DuPage FSC. Practice Ice may be purchased through the HEPD Ice Arena web site at www.hepdicearena.com (click on competition tab) beginning Tuesday August 2, 2011. The rink web site will have practice ice times, rules and pricing information.

NO PROGRAM MUSIC will be played during practice ice sessions - no exceptions. Each ½ hour session will have a maximum number of skaters allowed on the ice. Once that number has been met that practice ice session will be closed. Ice will be sold on a first come first serve basis. Ice payments will need to be made the day of the reservation with a valid CC#. No refunds will be issued for any reason and the form will need to be submitted. No phone or email reservations will be accepted.

Facility

The Triphahn Community Center & Ice Arena is located at 1685 W. Higgins Road, Hoffman Estates, IL 60169. Phone: 847-885-7500. The facility has two sheets of ice with seating and each surface measures 85' x 200'.

Official Notices

An official bulletin board will be maintained at the main arena. It is the responsibility of each competitor, parent and coach to check the board frequently for any schedule changes and additional information.

Scratches

No refunds will be made after the competition entry deadline of July 1, 2011. If you must withdraw from an event, please be considerate of other competitors and notify the registration desk as soon as possible.

Correct Event and Entry Changes

It is essential that you sign up for the correct level event and that your coach signs your entry form attesting to your level and event. Age and test requirements are the same as Free Skate events. Skaters must compete at the same level as their Free Skate event. Skaters cannot switch events or make changes after entries have closed on July 1st. Any change requests will be subject to the Chief Referee's discretion and will only be granted if a withdrawal occurs and an opening becomes available. Should the change be approved, you will need to pay an additional \$30 change fee. **In addition, please ensure your valid email address is printed legibly on the entry form in the event of any questions.**

Music

Competitors must provide their music on cassette tapes or CDs. All cassette tapes or CDs must be clearly marked with the skater's Name, Event, and Actual Time of Music ON THE SIDE TO BE PLAYED. Cassette tapes should be of good quality with only ONE piece of music per cassette and rewound to the beginning of the program. CDs must have only ONE track on it. In the case of short and long programs, two separate CDs (or cassettes) must be used. Damaged or improperly marked cassettes or CDs will not be accepted. For CDs, due to compatibility and reliability reasons, music should not be submitted on re-recordable "CD-RW" discs.

Music should be turned in at the designated check in area where their event is taking place (Rink 1 or Rink 2). COMPETITORS MUST HAVE A SUITABLE BACKUP CD OR CASSETTE DURING HIS/HER EVENT. Skaters are responsible for picking up their tapes and CDs at the arena check-in desk after your event. The DuPage FSC and the Hoffman Estates Park District Ice Arena are not responsible for tapes or CDs that are lost, damaged or left behind, and these will not be mailed back.

Registration Desk

The Registration Desk is located in the main lobby and will be open approximately 1 hour prior to the start of the competition each day and will remain open throughout the competition. Skaters must check in at least 1 hour prior to the start of their event warm up. Awards

Non-championship events will be divided into groups when necessary. Referee will seed Juvenile through Novice events. Awards will be presented to the top four placements in each group/flight; this includes the top four skaters in initial rounds and also final rounds. All awards will be presented off ice immediately following the completion of the event and posting of the results and pictures will be taken immediately thereafter as the awards are distributed.

Photography.

Photography still and action shots may be provided at the competition. Additional information and order forms will be available at the designated vendor table. No flash photography is permitted in the ice arenas.
